

Penguin Plunge 6th Annual Visit to Crystal Lake

Saturday March 23, 2013 was a cold, windy day when 113 brave plungers raised \$34,000 for Connecticut Special Olympics at Sandy Beach on Crystal Lake.

It was close to 40 degrees at plunge time with a gusty 20-40 mile wind, compared to a very mild day last year. Luckily, the lake had begun to thaw and cutting a hole in the ice was not required.
